Cornhole Tournament Rules - Run for Spud 2017

We will follow the ACA (American Cornhole Assoc.) rules as closely as possible, but will deviate from some rules due to time restraints and simplicity.

Entry Fees and Winnings

- \$10/team
- 100% to the Jimmy Fund

Court Layout and Equipment

- Platforms to be 27 ft apart.
- Standard 24" x 48" platforms with a 6" hole.

Play of the game

- Players must throw from behind the front of the platform.
- Players may throw from either side, but must throw an entire inning from the same side.
- Players will alternate throws.
 - Team that scored last throws first on the next half inning.
 - If no points are scored on the previous half inning, the other team throws first.

Foul Corn Bags

- Any bags that touches the ground before landing on the platform must be removed from the platform.
- If a player crosses the front of the platform while throwing, the bag must be removed from the platform.

Scoring

- 3 points are awarded for each bag that passes thru the hole.
- 1 point is awarded for each bag that comes to rest on the platform.
- At the end of the half inning, points are tallied for both teams. The net score is recorded. Ex. Team A scores 6 points and Team B scores 4 points. Team A is awarded 2 points for the half inning, Team B is awarded 0.

Size of the tournament

- The tournament will be limited to 32 teams.
- The games in the first (3) rounds will have a 10 minute time limit. All teams in a round will begin at the same time. The first team to score 21 will advance. If a team has not scored 21 points, the team leading at the end of 10 minutes will advance to the next round.
 - In the event of a tie at the end of 10 minutes, the game will go to sudden death.
 - No win by 2 points rule.
- The final four and finals will play to 21. No win by 2 points rule.
